New but inexpensive items including:

- Plastic baby spoons.
- Bibs.
- Baby Socks.
- Wash cloths.
- Disposable place mats.
- Disposable diaper bags.
- Diapers.
- Bath Toys.

Decorate a bag with adorable baby-themed images + place items inside.
