Shrinky Dinks Instructions

Take a sheet of shrinky dinks paper:

- make sure the <u>rough side is up</u> before starting if you are using colored pencils.
- make sure the <u>shiny side is up</u> before starting if you are using sharpies.
- 1. Tape your image down to the table/ surface underneath. You can also tape your shrinky dinks paper right onto the table. This will make it easier to trace & it shouldn't move underneath.

Tip: you can also add an extra sheet of paper under your image so that you don't damage any surfaces at home.

- 2. IMPORTANT: <u>You want to only use half of the page</u>, so move your image towards the side of one side of your paper. This way you can use the other half for a second image.
- 3. Be sure to look at your image and really focus on the colors used, details, etc.
- 4. You can remove the shrinky-dinks paper every once in a while to make sure you like the way it looks.
- 5. Once you fully trace & color your image, cut it out carefully.

Tip: sharp edges don't shrink too well, round them out instead of leaving them sharp.

<u>Baking</u>

- <u>Before baking, make sure that there is a hole punch.</u>
- Bake your image for approximately 1-2 minutes at 325 degrees
- WATCH IT SHRINK!
- Once it is cooled you can add a keychain or a necklace if you'd like!
