

Pretzel Spider Webs

- Total: 1 hr 20 min (includes setting time)
- Yield: 10 servings
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Ingredients

- Deselect All
 - 80 pretzel sticks
 - 2 cups white or chocolate candy melting wafers, or chocolate chips
 - 1/2 cup Halloween sprinkles
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- Chocolate spiders, optional

Directions

Special equipment:

a piping bag or zip lock bag

1. Line two sheet pans with parchment paper.
 2. In sets of 8, arrange the pretzel sticks into the spokes of 10 webs, with the centers touching and the outer edges spaced.
 3. Melt the melting wafers in microwave for 30 second intervals at 50% power, stir until smooth. Transfer to a piping bag or zip lock and cut the tip to create a small hole.
 4. Pipe a small amount of the melted candy onto parchment, take pretzel sticks and place pretzels around the center of each web where the pretzels meet; this will hold the webs together and place another dot on top. Then pipe a web pattern by starting in the center and spiraling out to the edges. Go around the outer edges a couple times to create a firm border. Carefully spoon over the sprinkles. Repeat with the remaining webs.
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5. Place chocolate spiders in the center, if using. Let set 1 hour.
