

## Pet Bandanas

Your kit comes with:

- a fabric quarter
- an iron-on dog patch

**\*You'll need an iron + scissors\***

### **1. Shaping:**

Fold your bandana into a triangle, by taking one corner and folding to the other corner. If it's not perfect that is ok! Simply cut off the excess material in the back.

### **2. Choose a place to iron on your patch!**

**OPTIONAL: If you also wanted to add phrases -either written or with letters- follow these next steps**

### **Phrases:**

-Think of a cute or sweet phrase for your pet (if using for a shelter think of a cute adoption phrase)

-You can use the list I have provided, or think of your own.

\*1 pack of the letters can create the attached phrases! The letters are about \$7-8 in craft stores or on Amazon. **The brand I used was called Dritz# 15360**

### **You can keep your fabric scraps:**

-Keep your scraps so that you can test different fabric marker colors to see what looks best with your bandana.

-Add a thick piece of cardstock in between the two layers so that the markers won't drip through or stick.

You can also Use stencils for cute images and words. Think paw prints, hearts & flowers. \*they even sell stencils at dollar tree!
